
UCPath: Paving the Way for Future Growth

Risks

- 11 different payroll technologies system-wide.
- Existing systems require manual calculations and processes, which can result in avoidable errors and rework.
- Existing technologies are insufficient for UC's complex employee population and changing business needs.
- Existing systems are nearly 40 years old!

UCPath will support nearly 200,000 UC employees across 10 campuses, 5 health systems and 5 locations

(Agriculture and Natural Resources, ASUCLA, Hastings College of Law, Lawrence Berkeley National Lab, and UC Office of the President).


Experts from throughout the UC System have worked together to standardize more


